## Civic and Community Engagement

Builds grassroots leaders' skills and knowledge to organize groups through dialogues and civic problem-solving strategies that lead to more inclusive, equitable, and sustainable communities.

- **Dialogue to Change** is a three-step approach to creating sustainable solutions to local civic issues. The depth and quality of our interactive, inclusive dialogues focus on an exchange of ideas and a commitment to address systemic oppression.
- **Leadership Initiatives** build the capacity for everyday people to organize, facilitate, and drive sustainable change in their communities. Current initiatives include: Interdependent Democracy Innovation Lab, Connecticut Civic Ambassadors, and Anchor Partner Network.
